Accessing Lectures Online (Echo360)

UC uses the software Echo360 to record lectures. Lecturers make these recordings available in AKO | LEARN via the course recordings 'block', with the Echo360 logo. The ECHO360 block will appear either on the right-hand side of your course or under *Course Blocks* at the top right. Please note that unless the lecture is being live streamed, it may take up to an hour after the scheduled lecture for the recording to appear in your AKO | LEARN course site.

How do I Playback Course Recordings?

The ECHO360 block takes you to a list of current and future scheduled course recordings in Echo360. A processed course recording can be selected and played in the Echo360 player. Click on the obutton to play the recording


How to View an ECHO360 Live-Streamed Class

Your lecturer may have decided to live-stream your ECHO 360 class. The live video stream cannot be rewound/fast-forwarded; it is happening in real-time. But course recordings are usually still available to be viewed after the class in the ECHO360 block.

Go to your LEARN course site and go to the Course Recordings block to access Echo360



Lectures that are scheduled to be live streamed will have a **LIVE** icon next to each lecture instance. To view the live stream, simply click on the green play button when the lecture is being presented.
